It is the policy of the Yellowstone Country Assistance Network to screen and inform all potential applicants of CSBG funded services of the federal and state income guidelines for this program.

Under the terms of our contract Yellowstone Country Assistance Network may not approve CSBG funded services for any applicant that through an application process requiring proof of income which indicates the applicant(s) is over two hundred percent (200%) of the FFY 2020 Federal Poverty Guidelines.

CSBG Eligibility Requirements. Abide by the federal eligibility requirements of the program through an application process which requires proof of income that indicates the applicant(s) is at or below two hundred percent (200%) of the FFY 2020 Federal Poverty Guidelines

CARES Act. Abide by the federal eligibility requirements of the program through an application process requires proof of income that indicates the applicant(s) is **at or below** two hundred percent (200%) of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Beginning October 1, 2020, the 2020 poverty guidelines will be used to determine eligibility until September 30, 2021. Beginning October 1, 2021, the 2021 poverty guidelines will be used to determine eligibility until September 30, 2022.
